

Outstanding Certificates within the Classroom:

Outstanding work or behavior within the classroom

Clip move to the top of clip chart

- Copy goes home to inform parent
- Certificate goes in hallway on board for recognition
- Student of the week chosen from recipients of Outstanding certificates

Small BUG Slips: (Principal 300 Club)

Each teacher/staff member will get one per week

Given to students following school wide expectations in areas outside of the classroom (exception would be staff members who teach specials, music, etc.)

Students come down the following morning and draw a number from the bag for the Principal 300 Club. Ticket goes on window. Their name goes in the Celebrity Book along with the behavior that earned them the ticket.

Once there are 10 tickets in a row in any direction, those students will earn a Mystery Motivator which will be done during their recess.

Student of the Week:

Each week, homeroom teachers will submit one student who earned the Student of the Week by Friday morning. They will have a certificate with their name and picture up on the front board as you enter the building. They will be

recognized in the newsletter on the Monday following the weekend.

Student of the Month:

Teachers will choose one student who has been Outstanding for the month. They will submit the name by the last Wednesday of the month. They will have a certificate with their name and picture. They will spin the prize wheel for a special activity or privilege. They will also be highlighted in the news broadcast created by the Student Leadership Team and the school newsletter.
