- Nominations were as follows Chairperson: Edie Morgan nominated Lee Norton. Benny seconded the nomination. Christina Leavitt nominated Jessica Balderas. Gene McIntyre seconded the nomination. Each of the nominees shared information regarding their background. A paper vote was conducted and Jessica Balderas was voted Chairperson. Vice Chairperson: Bruce Simpson nominated Lee Norton as vice chair. Edie Morgan seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous. Secretary: Jenny Kearl was nominated as secretary. Bruce Simpson seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous. Length of Terms: Christina Leavitt motioned for the chair to be a 2 year position and secretary to be a 1 year position. Sonal seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous.
- Review of SCC Operating Procedures The schedule of meetings, procedure for minutes, and member list were reviewed. A copy of the operating procedures is located on the school website under SCC.
- **Plan for Shared Governance**-Christina Leavitt shared Becky Pittam offered to come and provide training in October or November's SCC meeting.

- 1. An SIC chair was elected: Lisa Gifford
- 2. Notes in SIC meetings will be taken by Staci Pugmire.
- 3. Music Proposals: A discussion was held pertaining to the music program and the issue of money. The committee went grade by grade to ascertain each groups' suggestions. The suggestions are in no particular grade order.
- Find the money to fulfill our oral obligations. Don't opt out of any part of the programs as they are. Dividing Jen's group in half to go to Michelle and Leland when she is not teaching is unfair to them.

- Some grades could have music and dance for half a year. This might free up times that could be used in other ways.
- Fundraising was suggested by some grades while other grades felt fund raising/asking parents for more money was a negative idea.
- The plan Jen sent out to cut back music a few of the weeks was supported. This group said they will support the other plan as first proposed by Pieter and Jen if that is what parents and affected grade levels prefer.
- · Omit some programming.
- Use resources for what are the most important priorities.
- Can PTA funds pay for Tanner Dance?
- Grants that are funded could go to Tanner Dance, not Jen's salary.
- Debora reiterated there is no money in 1033 account.
- Borrowing against next March's revenue from Art Night was discussed and discarded.
- Some grades preferred holding Jen's hours to 19 while others preferred funding the full 24 hours. After much discussion, SIC recommends the last (3rd) option proposed by Jen. Jen would work 19 hours. Some music instruction time would be given up during Informance weeks, and Jen's time would be given to the upper grade music blocks. Debora will ask Jen to visually display what the 3rd option would look like for presentation at our next faculty meeting on Monday, September 18th.
- 4. Class size in the upper grades was discussed. Debora said that the issue must be what's best for our kids and that we must be flexible. She said that the issue must be addressed this year or next. We may need to allocate an FTE for 6th grade next year or make some adjustments in the lower grades.
- 5. The Owl Team is being formed. Members of the team will include Debora Cluff, Pam Roberts, Maryjane Moore, Sarah Daniels, Valerie Blamires, Beau Bishop, and Wendy Traub.

Principal Report:

Debora asked for parent input regarding how to address music teacher budget. The schedule
was given to parents at SCC. The committee indicated option 3 for this year and then gathering
input from the community as to how to proceed for next year. A suggestion was to have a
survey done at our winter performance where we have a large community turnout as to what
programs ARTs Night supports.

- Christina asked whether we wanted to use California Pizza Kitchen as a fundraiser. The committee chose to not burden parents financially with another fundraiser.
